COMEDIAN AND POLITICAL PUNDIT DENNIS MILLER MAKES NORTHERN QUEST CASINO DEBUT OCT. 12

SPOKANE, WA. (Sept. 29) – Comedian Dennis Miller, considered to be the best “news anchor” in the 33-year history of “Saturday Night Live,” brings his sophisticated blend of humor, word-play and ranting political commentary to Northern Quest Casino for a single show Oct. 12 in the Pend Oreille Pavilion.

A native of Pittsburgh with a degree in journalism, Miller began his entertainment career by hosting a local teen television show and honing his skills working the comedy club circuit. In the early 1980s, Miller lost out to comedian Sinbad on the TV talent showcase “Star Search.”

Miller was discovered in a comedy club by “SNL” executive producer Lorne Michaels, who signed him to anchor “Weekend Update” on the late-night program.

The visibility from the spot, plus his acerbic, wisecracking quips and off-the-cuff commentary, led him to a variety of gigs after he left “SNL” following a six-year run. In addition to performing stand-up comedy, Miller – whose forte has become extended, well-reasoned political rants - found a niche in television as host of his own late-night show and appearances as a political pundit on cable

news shows.

His most improbable gig came during the 2000-2001 NFL seasons, when he provided color commentary as part of the “Monday Night Football” broadcast team. Considered by many as “too hip for the room” with his obscure references and comparisons, Miller left the booth and continued with his comedy career in live venues and on television.

Last year, Miller launched a live, nationally syndicated daily radio show and continues to contribute his conservative-leaning comedy observations on Fox News.
