

SLOTS

There's nothing quite like it—seeing 7s line-up, watching the lights flash, showing everyone in the casino that you've just hit the big one! That's the fun and excitement you came for!

You can play the slots with single or multiple credits. Entering the maximum credit raises the amount of the payoff.

To win, you line up a combination of symbols. Each machine has a pay table that details the payout according to which symbols line up. Some machines offer a payout on multiple lines, directions, and bonus play. Just remember, your payouts are larger when you play the maximum credit!

At management's discretion, payment of a jackpot may be made by check.

VIDEO SLOT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Insert your Camas Rewards card.
- 2. Insert ticket and/or cash in the machine into the slot marked "Ticket In."
- To play, choose the number of credits and/or number of pay lines, push the "Spin" button on the screen or the "Start Play" button on the button panel. Credits will be added/deducted on the credit meter.
- 4. To cash out, push the "Cash Out" button and your ticket will be dispensed from the machine. Verify the accuracy of your slot ticket before leaving the machine. You may use that ticket to play another slot machine or you can convert the ticket into cash at a money center or the cashier's cage.

BLACKJACK

Blackjack or "21" is the most popular casino game. One of the biggest reasons for its popularity is that it's a simple contest between you and the dealer.

The object of "21" is to beat the dealer by drawing cards that add up to 21, or as close to 21 as possible without exceeding that number. The jack, queen and king count as ten and the ace counts as one or 11, whichever you prefer. All other cards count as their face value.

THE GAME

The dealer starts the game by dealing two cards to you. He also deals two cards to himself, one face up and one face down.

WITH YOUR TWO CARDS YOU CAN EITHER:

- 1. Stay (get no more cards) by waving your hand palm down over the table.
- Get a hit: (receive one or more cards) by motioning towards you with your hand or tapping the table.

BLACKJACK

This is when your first two cards total 21 (a face card and an ace). You are paid $1\frac{1}{2}$ times your original bet. If the dealer also has blackjack then you push or tie.

The dealer must draw cards when his total is 16 or less and must stand on a hard 17 or better.



INSURANCE

This is a protection bet for the player and pays 2 to 1. When a dealer has an ace showing, the player has the option to take insurance by wagering up to half of his bet on the "Insurance Line." If a dealer has a blackjack you win the insurance bet and you lose your insurance bet if the dealer does not.

DOUBLING DOWN

If your first two cards total a combination that you feel will only take a single card draw to beat the dealer, you may double your bet. Remember, you can draw only one additional card. You may double down after splitting, except on aces.

SPLITTING

If your first two cards are of equal value, you can play two hands by matching the amount of your original bet on each hand. You may split up to three times for a total of four hands. You can draw as many cards as you like for each hand. Aces may be re-split, but you can only draw one card for each hand.

CRAPS

You can easily find a "Dice" table. Just look in the direction of the cheering. It would be hard to imagine a casino game with more excitement than craps!

One of the big reasons craps is so exciting is because it offers so many ways to win. But don't think you have to make all kinds of bets to have fun; you can enjoy the game even if you stay with the simplest bets.

HERE ARE THE BETTING OPTIONS AVAILABLE TO YOU:

PASS LINE An even money bet. On the "Come Out" roll (the first roll) you win on a natural seven or eleven or lose on "craps" (two, three or twelve). Any other number rolled is your "point", and you must throw your point again before a seven to win.

DON'T PASS LINE Opposite of the Pass Line. You lose on a natural seven or eleven on the first roll. You win on two or three (twelve is a tie). Any other number rolled is the point, and you win if a seven is rolled before the point.

ODDS Once a point is made on the first roll or a come point on a succeeding roll, you may take the odds and win if the point or come points are made before a seven. "Don't Pass" bets are in reverse: you must lay the odds in order to win.

COME BETS Come bets are made after a point has been established. They then move to the next number rolled. Odds can then be placed just like on the pass line. You need that number then to roll again before a seven to win. You win on a natural seven or eleven and lose on craps (two, three or twelve). Any number that comes up is a "Come-Point" and must be thrown before a seven is thrown.

ROULETTE

Roulette, the American version of the oldest and most popular European gambling games, is easy and fun to play.

THE GAME

You place a bet with casino chips or special colored roulette chips. If you wish to buy roulette chips, the dealer will give you your own colored chips so he will always know which bets are yours. The colored chips may be valued at \$1, \$5, \$25 or \$100. These special colored chips must be redeemed at the roulette table before you leave.

You place your bets, and the dealer spins the ball. If it lands where you placed your chip, you win!

How many numbers your chip has covered determines the payoff odds.

SPANISH 21

Spanish 21 is played like blackjack except there are no tens (10s) in the deck. Because of this there are many exciting variations in pay-outs.

BIG PAYOFFS

VARIATIONS FROM BLACKJACK

Uses six Spanish decks A-9, J, Q, K (no 10's)

- All blackjacks paid 3 to 2, never push, always BEATS dealer's blackjack.
- 2. All 21s are paid immediately, never push.
- 3. Split aces treated like other split pairs, in that you can receive more than one card on them.
- 4. Double down after splitting.
- 5. Double down once with two or more cards.*

FREE BET BLACKJACK

Free Bet Blackjack is played like blackjack except it doesn't cost any extra money to double-down or split! It also offers some fun bonus betting!

Free Bet follows the basic rules of blackjack, with the additional features below:

- 1. "Free" double-down on first two-card hard totals of 9, 10, or 11
- 2. "Free" splits on all pairs except 10 (10-10, J-J, Q-Q, or K-K variation) value cards
- "Free" double-down allowed after split or "Free" split
- 4. "Free" re-splits allowed up to four hands
- 5. All normal splits allowed
- 6. Regular doubles allowed on two-card hands

PAI GOW

If you play poker or video poker, you'll love Pai Gow Poker. The best part is that you already know the basics. In addition, our Pai Gow Poker dealers will be happy to assist you in learning this fast, easy game.

THE GAME

Pai Gow Poker combines elements of the ancient Chinese game of Pai Gow and the American game of poker. It is played with a traditional deck of 52 playing cards, plus one joker. The joker can be used as an ace, or to complete a straight, a flush, or a straight flush.

RANKING THE HANDS

- Each player at the table is dealt seven cards, which the player arranges to make two hands; a two-card hand and a five-card hand.
- Rankings are based on basic poker ratings. Thus, the highest two-card hand would be two aces, and the highest five-card hand would be a Royal Flush.

 The five-card hand must be higher than the two-card hand (if the two-card hand is a pair of sevens, for example, the five-card hand must contain at least a pair of eights or higher).

OBJECT OF THE GAME

The object of the game is for both of your hands to rank higher than both of the banker's hands. Your low hand and your high hand must beat the banker's in order to win. If your low hand wins, but your high hand loses, it is a push. If either hand ties with the banker, then the banker wins that hand.

PLAY OF THE GAME

The game is dealt from an automated shuffler. The cards will then be placed by the dealer in front of each player (including the dealer) in a counter clockwise rotation from the starting point indicated by random generation. After all positions are dealt seven cards, the remaining four-card stub is fanned out and placed in the discard rack. Each player then arranges his cards into a two-card low hand and a five-card high hand as described in "RANKING THE HANDS." The dealer does not look at their cards until all players have set their hands in the designated spaces face down. The dealer then turns their cards over and sets their hand in front of the tray face up. The player's/banker's hand is compared to the dealer's hand first.

PLAY ANTE

Bet on the ANTE spot to play against the dealer's hand. It's just you and the dealer! Dealer qualifies with queen high or better. When the dealer does not play, the PLAY bet pushes, ANTE pays 1 to 1.

If you bet on the ANTE spot and like your hand, you must place a wager on the PLAY spot that is equal to the ANTE. (PLAY spot only ever pays 1 to 1 if the dealer qualifies.) It's your three-card poker hand against the dealer's three-card poker hand; best hand wins!

PLAY BOTH

It's you and the cards for a pair or better. It's you and the dealer for the best three-card poker hand. You must also make the PLAY wager or you will forfeit both the ANTE and PAIR PLUS wagers.

ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD'EM

Ultimate Texas Hold'em uses a standard 52-card deck. It features head-to-head play and an optional bonus bet.

HOW TO PLAY

You and the dealer each receive two cards. They combine them with five community cards to make the best five-card hand.

BETTING

Initially, bets are placed on the ante and the blind, which must be at equal value. The cards are then dealt. If you bet pre-flop, you may risk 3x or 4x the ante.

If you bet on the flop, you may bet 2x the ante. If you wait until all cards are out, you may only bet 1x the ante. The ante and play are paid 1 to 1 if won.

BONUS BETS

The game features two bonus bets, one optional and one mandatory. The optional bet is called "Trips."

• Players win the trips bonus if their final five-card hand is three of a kind or better

THE MANDATORY BET IS CALLED THE "BLIND."

- The blind wager may win, lose, or push
- It wins when the player has a straight or better and beats the dealer
- It loses when the player loses
- It pushes when the dealer and the player tie, or when the player has less than a straight and beats the dealer

BLIND BET PAYOUTS

The player must beat the dealer to win these payments

Royal Flush
Straight Flush pays 50 to 1
Four-of-a-Kind
Full House
Flush
$Straight. \ \ldots \ \ldots \ \ldots \ \ldots \ \ldots \ \ pays 1 to 1$

If a player loses to the dealer, the blind wager always loses. If the player ties the dealer, the blind wager always pushes. If the player wins less than a straight, the blind wager always pushes.

A player playing a trips wager shall be paid in accordance with the following payout table:

POKER

Poker is America's favorite game. The most regularly played game in our friendly, comfortable, non-smoking poker room is Texas Hold'em.

TEXAS HOLD'EM

Each player receives two cards face down. Five cards are turned up in the center of the table and used by all the players. Players may use any combination of their two hole cards plus the five community cards on the table to make the best five-card poker hand. To play, the first player to the left of the dealer button must bet "in the blind" or before any cards are dealt. (In some games, two or more blinds are required.) After the first two are dealt, players may call the blind bet, raise or fold. Players required to bet, "in the blind," have an option to raise the blind on the first round of betting. After the first three cards are turned up ("the flop") each player starting with the first player to the left of the dealer button may check, bet, call, raise or fold. On each round of betting after the flop, the player to the left of the button starts the action. Betting limits double after the "fourth street" is dealt in structured games.

SPORTS BETTING

At Turf Club Sports Book, you can put down money on your favorite teams and games. Before you get in on the action, there are a number of bets to choose from.

TYPES OF BETS:

SPREAD BET: A wager on a single game with a point spread. Simply cover the spread to win.

MONEY LINE BET: A bet on a specific team to win, without a point spread to cover.

OVER/UNDER BET: Betting that the total combined score of both teams will be over or under a set number.

FUTURE BETS: Wagers placed on a contest at a later date.

PARLAY BETS: Combining multiple single bets into one big bet for a larger payout.

TEASER BETS: Combining multiple single bets into one big bet, with the ability to alter the point spread.

ROUND ROBIN BETS: A series of smaller parlays created from a larger list of bets.

PROP BETS: A wager not tied to the result of a contest.

BASIC LINGO:

ACTION: Having a wager of any kind on a contest.

COVER: For a favorite, to win by more than the point spread. For an underdog, to win the game or lose by less than the spread.

LINE: Both the point spread or odds of a game.

OFF THE BOARD: A game in which no wagering is available.

PICK/PICK 'EM: A game without a favorite or underdog, meaning the spread is zero.

HOW TO PLACE A BET

- Check out the odds display screen to view all the games and lines currently offered.
- Once you've decided which bets to place, walk up to the betting counter with cash in-hand. Please note: credit cards and checks are not accepted.
- 3. Tell the cashier the game ID, bet amount, and the bet type that you'd like to place.
- 4. Before leaving the counter, check that your ticket information is correct.
- 5. Put your ticket in a safe place.
- 6. Find a seat on property with a great view of the live sports action.
- If you win your bet, return to the betting counter and hand the cashier your ticket to collect your payout.

HOW TO PLACE A SPORTS BET AT THE KIOSK

- 1. Insert cash into the bill collector.
- Betting options will appear on the kiosk screen. Select the game, betting amount, and bet type you'd like to place.
- 3. Place bet and print your ticket.
- If you win your bet, visit the betting counter and hand the cashier your ticket to collect your payout.
